◆ **Control and Hazard Banding Applications** ◆

Control Banding has several variations but these are quickly becoming standardized methods to assess health risks of chemicals in occupational settings. The purpose is to provide a focus on the end point rather than the assessment. The Enform Control Chemical Hazard Webtool was developed from a documented program with both available online. The Webtool will be demonstrated by entering chemical ingredients and seeing the tool assign a Hazard Grouping, identifying workplace parameters (quantity and relative volatility or dustiness). This product produces a Risk Assessment with results focused on simple strategies to control hazards.

There will be a brief history of Control Banding systems and how the Enform system evolved from need to a working control banding site that has toxicity information imbedded into ingredients to generate a hazard group. We will discuss the "Fracking" application where less hazardous materials were substituted as well as other uses. Please bring your laptop computer to further participate in the interactive learning exercises.

Michael Phibbs is a Principle at Chemscape Safety Technologies where he has authored thousands of MSDSs and uses this knowledge to extract data and integrate it into management systems.

 **Directions to the 2223 Fulton Street Building in Berkeley:**

BART: The training location is two short blocks from the Downtown Berkeley BART Station. After exiting the station, walk south on Shattuck Ave toward Allston Way. Turn left onto Kittredge after one block, and walk up one block to Fulton Street. Entrance to the building is directly in front of where Kittredge and Fulton meet.

DRIVING: From West-bound CA-24: Take CA-13 NORTH exit towards Berkeley. Continue on Highway 13 (aka, Tunnel Road, and then Ashby) until you reach College Avenue. Turn right onto College and proceed almost one mile until you reach Bancroft Way. Turn left and proceed five blocks until you reach Fulton.

From all other points: Take I-980 EAST to CA-24 EAST and exit at Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Continue northbound on MLK until you reach Adeline Street. Merge onto Adeline and continue until you merge with Shattuck. Continue on Shattuck until you reach Durant. Take a right turn onto Durant. Take first left onto Fulton and continue two blocks.

When you enter the building, take the escalator to the sixth floor where you will be directed to the conference room.

PARKING: There is a parking garage at 2165 Kittredge Street, between Oxford and Shattuck. Parking is \$10 for 3 hours. Street parking is also available along Fulton Street.
