The recognition of respiratory problems caused by silica dust dates back to ancient Greeks and Romans. As the single most common occupational lung disease worldwide and an irreversible condition with no known cure, identifying the underlying causes and potential prevention of silicosis is of paramount importance.

We will be identifying the various types of silica and silicates and looking at the history of their use in the U.S., as well as exploring ties between silicosis and cancer. We will note historic standards along with a new proposed standard from Federal OSHA. Case studies, sample collection, and analysis will help identify exposures as well as increase our understanding of potential problems. Then we will review exposures and controls, from neighborhood ambient air quality to larger, internationally based sources of contamination.
